Lesson Title: Lessons in Good Trouble

1. **Activist**-Someone who brings about political or social change through acts such as campaigning or protests.
2. **Protest**- Publicly objecting to something through actions such as marching, chanting, holding signs, etc.
3. **Counterprotest**- Publicly moving in opposition to a protest through action.
4. **Social justice movement**- A group of people taking action to bring about the human and civil rights of all people, including equal rights and equal opportunities.
5. **Human rights**- Basic rights that all humans should possess.
6. **Civil rights**- Rights that humans possess for equal rights and opportunities regardless of sex, race, sexual preference, religion, etc.
7. **Racism**- The belief that one race is below another race, or inferior to another race simply because it is a different color.
8. **Equality**- The same opportunities, rights and responsibilities for all members of society regardless of their race, gender, sexual preference, religion, etc.
9. **Tolerance**- Having an understanding with and being okay that someone else may think differently than you even if you don't approve of it.
10. **Oppression**- When a group of people are treated unfairly by someone who holds a place of power (policies, laws, etc.)
11. **Catalyst**- A person or thing that causes an event or a change to happen
